The project required multimodal logistics and close coordination between international partners.

Canaan Group handled the inland transport in Canada, transfer onto flat-rack containers, lashing & securing operations, export customs clearance, and ocean freight. STERNE Group then handled the direct coordination of on-carriage transport from the port to Aberdeen in Scotland, route planning for the oversized transport, final delivery to site, and unloading using 2 mobile cranes, always ensuring the safe handling of the units.

The project highlights **strong international coordination and specialist expertise** in handling OOG transport.

Laso Lasarte Wind Deliver Last of 121 Wind Turbines in Morocco

Laso Lasarte Wind (LLW) have completed the delivery of the last of 121 wind turbines for the Aftissat Wind Farm in Morocco.

Aftissat is a major onshore wind energy extension project in the Boujdour Province, South of Laayoune in the Sahara region with an installed capacity of 460mw.

The project was divided into four phases and for the completion of this final phase, Laso Lasarte Wind deployed a fleet of **25 specialised vehicles** capable of transporting the **90m-long blades** as well as other main components with individual weights of up to **100tn**, from the Port of Laayoune to the site located **200km** away.

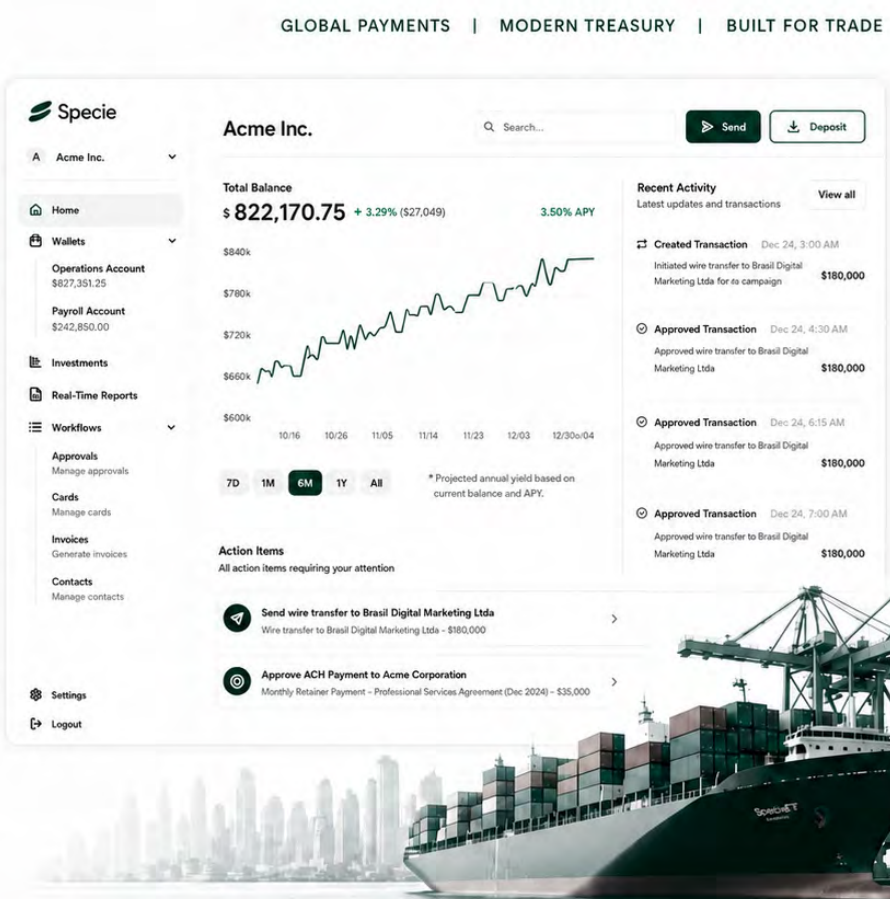

Successfully Deliver Project Shipment to Kenya Despite Regional Challenges

The Project Logistics Team at Polaris Shipping Agencies in the UAE have successfully completed a series of critical cross-trade shipments despite significant operational challenges arising from the evolving geopolitical situation in the Middle East.

Regional disruptions, including the suspension of several shipping services and restricted access to key UAE ports following the closure of the Strait of Hormuz, demanded **swift strategic planning, operational flexibility, and innovative logistics solutions..**

One of the project's key assignments involved the transportation of **1,200ft** of project cargo, with individual unit weights of up to **24mtn**. The shipment included JCB backhoe loaders, XCMG articulated boom lifts, and tower cranes destined for Mombasa, Kenya.

Originally scheduled to sail directly from Jebel Ali Port, the shipment was impacted by the suspension of direct vessel services. This unexpected development required Polaris to rapidly redesign the logistics plan to maintain the project schedule.

Drawing on their **extensive expertise in project cargo management**, Polaris evaluated multiple contingency routes through Saudi Arabia and Oman. Following a comprehensive operational assessment, Port Sohar in Oman was selected as the most efficient and reliable alternative gateway.

The time-sensitive breakbulk cargo was relocated to a designated staging facility, where each unit underwent detailed technical preparation. Where required, the equipment was partially dismantled to optimise transport efficiency, professionally packed in accordance with international standards, and securely containerised before being shipped onward from Port Sohar to Mombasa.

Throughout the execution of the project, the Polaris team successfully overcame numerous operational challenges, including extended border clearance times, evolving customs procedures, transit congestion, and rapidly changing regional conditions. Through meticulous planning, proactive risk management, continuous monitoring, and close coordination with clients, transport providers, port authorities, and overseas partners, the team ensured that the project moved according to schedule while minimising delays.

This successful operation underscores Polaris Project Logistics' commitment to **operational excellence, adaptability, and customer-centric services**. Even under extraordinary circumstances, the company demonstrated their ability to engineer **practical and dependable logistics solutions** for complex international project cargo movements.

Pinto Basto Deliver 443 Pipes for Angola Water Supply Project



Pinto Basto have overseen the discharge of another 443 pipes for a major water supply and sanitation project in Luanda, Angola. Once completed, the project will significantly enhance access to drinking water for 5 million people.

This shipment forms part of a large-scale logistics operation comprising of **14 consignments** shipped on general cargo vessels, requiring **close coordination** among all stakeholders involved in the transport and logistics chain.

To ensure the successful execution of the operation, Pinto Basto established a dedicated project team, bringing together professionals based in Angola and specialists deployed from Portugal to supervise discharge activities and ensure **maximum efficiency** throughout every stage of the process.

As both the ship agent and freight forwarder in Angola, Pinto Basto played a central role in

supporting the cargo consignee and coordinating activities between the shipowner, stevedoring company, road transporter, shipper, and consignee. They were also responsible for managing and processing all documentation related to the shipment and import procedures.

The successfully completed operation involved the discharge of **443 pipes** before **148 truck journeys** for the inland transportation, highlighting the logistical complexity associated with an infrastructure project of this scale.

Megalift Malaysia Report Transportation of Rail Equipment



Megalift in Malaysia have successfully completed the transportation of multiple heavy rail equipment components from two locations in Johor to Bukit Broga, Semenyih.

The operation involved the movement of various specialised cargo, including:

- 3 Units of Locomotives - each at 15.7 x 2.8 x 3.6m / 56tn
- 5 Units of Wagons - each at 13.0 x 2.5 x 2.0 / 17.5tn
- 6 Units of Rail Sets - each at 6tn
- 1 Unit of Flash Butt Machine with Frame - 21tn

Handling specialised rail equipment such as this requires **precise planning, careful coordination, and the right expertise** to ensure a safe and efficient delivery - Megalift met the challenge.
