- Transportation of fully loaded aircraft from Tianjin Airport (TSN) to Bishkek Airport (FRU);

- Arrangement of unloading operations at the arrival airport in Bishkek;
- Operations survey & cargo inspection upon arrival to airport in Bishkek;
- Customs formalities upon arrival of cargo to Bishkek Airport;
- Arrangement of transshipment procedures in Bishkek Airport;
- Delivery of cargo by road transport to final destination.

C.H. Robinson Delivers Equipment for Power Station Refit

The team at C.H.
Robinson recently
shipped pressure
vessels, storage
tanks and accessories to the UAE for a
power station refit.



The terminal in Jebel Ali was originally considered as the destination in the UAE which required the customer to pay a 5% duty. The experts at C.H. Robinson suggested that instead, the cargo arrived at a terminal in Sharjah to avoid the additional cost. A part charter was chosen for shipping the cargo from a port in Malaysia so they could control which terminal the carrier berthed at in the UAE.

In all, 99mt of equipment was loaded on the ocean vessel with the largest piece measuring 20.7 x 4.2 x 4.8m and weighing 64mt.

C.H. Robinson Transports Equipment for Potash Mine in Australia

The specialists at C.H. Robinson recently completed a project to transport water treatment equipment to Australia for a new potash mine. Overall, 28 pieces of crystallizer equipment were shipped by two part-charters over four months.

When the equipment first arrived at the port of departure in China, it was discovered that the lifting lugs attached to the equipment were not standard. So C.H. Robinson immediately had special shackles brought in to rectify the problem which allowed the pieces to be loaded onto the ocean vessel safely.

The vessel's departure ended up being delayed due to changes to cargo lists, cargo readiness, bad weather, and issues at the port due to an unrelated vessel incident a few days before. However, constant communication, including regular meetings with the customer, kept everyone up-to-date until the cargo was safely dispatched and arrived at the destination.



C.H. Robinson Handle Shipping of LOX Tanks

C.H. Robinson recently took on a project to deliver two LOX tanks, each weighing 203.5mtn, from China to Houston.

The tanks were received at the port in Shanghai and loaded onto the ocean vessel, one on deck and one under deck. Once safely secured, the vessel set sail to Texas and was on the water for a total of eight weeks before it reached the Port of Houston.

Throughout the project, the logistics experts at C.H. Robinson worked as an extension of their customer's team by working through the details and proactively discussing any potential issues ahead of time. Constant communication was required with all parties involved to ensure all documentation was in place so the cargo could be unloaded without delay.

Once the vessel arrived at the Port of Houston, an experienced C.H. Robinson project manager was onsite to ensure the tanks were safely offloaded from the vessel and onto a barge for the next leg of their journey.

165.5tn / 15.2 x 13.7 x 11.0m

The scope of services handled by M-Star included:

Transportation from the suppliers by SPMTs - 2 x 12-axles;

Port handlings & shipment on heavy lift vessel;

Receiving & handling at Port of Discharge;

Delivery to site, placing next to oil platform, on SPMTs again;

Full documentation, removal of road obstacles, road permits & escorts;

Pre-surveys, cargo inspections, calculations for stabilisation, rigging and sea fastening plans for the vessel.

KGE Baltic Delivers Wind Power Project to Belarus

n January, KGE Baltic were invited to handle a difficult project of a Vestas Wind System (WTG 136) delivered from various origins in Europe to the Asmolovichi jobsite in Belarus. It was necessary to deliver the goods in very short notice with only 3 weeks to prepare for such huge dimensions so KGE had to make all arrangements quickly.

The first parts of the project, which were located in Denmark and the Netherlands, are outlined below. They were delivered by multimodal transport to the base in Asmolovichi in a sequence with around 1-2 days in-between loads.

- 3 OOG loads transported directly from Videbæk in Denmark to Belarus:
- Nacelle 12.86 x 4.00 x 3.41 / 66,300kg
- Hub 5.46 x 3.74 x 3.43 / 32,000kg
- Drive Train 7.23 x 3.50 x 3.20 / 61,100kg
- 1 x Low-Bed (Blade Gripper)
- 1 x Curtain Trailer (Stand)
- 1 x 40' Container (Spare Parts)
- 1 x Flatbed Trailer

The remaining cargo consisted of 6 windmill tower sections which were sent by the customer from Spain to Ventspils Harbour in Latvia by breakbulk vessel. After the vessel arrived, the KGE team performed all arrangements including accepting the vessel on berth, unlashing & unwelding, discharging from vessel & pier, loading onto trucks, dismantling the harbour gates to leave the port, all transit formalities, surveys, drone filming and more. The specifications of the 6 pieces were:

- Top Section 32.36 x 3.26 x 3.67 / 58,000kg
- Mid Section One 8.20 x 4.98 x 4.99 / 81,000kg
- Mid Section Two 21.84 x 4.18 x 4.98 / 78,000kg
- Mid Section Three 26.88 x 3.93 x 4.18 / 82,500kg
- Mid Section Four 28.00 x 3.67 x 3.93 / 68,000kg
- Bottom Section 12.33 x 4.39 x 5.30 / 82,000kg

All the cargo was delivered to the job site safely and in perfect condition. The KGE team executed the project with professionalism and made all possible efforts to ensure there were no issues or delays.

Modjo Port Project by ScanProTrans & Freight in Time

The project involved 10 units of full container reach stackers, 7 units of empty container reach stackers and 3 units of heavy forklift trucks (25-28th capacity). All the machines were more or less dismantled with the heaviest pieces at 70th down to the smallest at 34th. In total, 55 flat-racks and containers were used as well as 20 units of out-of-gauge flat-racks loaded with the main bodies.

Managing Director at ScanProTrans, Attila Vass explains; "We started this project in 2018 with Konecranes by quoting them transportation for port and industrial handling equipment from Sweden to Modjo Port in Ethiopia via Djibouti. As the financer was the World Bank, it took 2 years, but finally it was time for execution!

After long and very precise discussions with FIT, Konecranes and the shipping line, CMA-CGM, we agreed to ship the lot in 3 batches so FIT were able to execute the onward transportation of one batch before the second arrived as we managed to negotiate 21 days free time in Djibouti Port. The cargo was received and loaded by MIMAB, who are ScanProTrans owners and the only privately owned terminal inside Gothenburg Port.

The works in Sweden and the CMA-CGM transportation to Djibouti went smoothly and without delay. In Djibouti, we faced some problems as the documentation was not completely arranged so all the cargo was stuck for longer than expected but with the support of all involved, the issue was quickly solved. Finally, with a few minor incidents, all the 55 flat-racks and containers along with the 20 machine main bodies were delivered to Modjo to everyone's satisfaction.

This was a rather complicated project with a huge crowd of people involved all depending on each other's dedication, but thanks to the professionalism of all parties, the project was successfully finalised."

C.H. Robinson Handles Urgent Shipment to Saudi Arabia

C.H. Robinson have handled and the safe loading and shipping of 24 seismic vibrator vehicles by ocean vessel to Saudi Arabia. Their project logistics experts were onsite at the Port of Houston right up to Christmas Eve 2020 to oversee the operations.

The vehicles measure 10.21 x 3.29 x 3.44m and weigh 30.4mtn each. C.H. Robinson explain; "This type of cargo would usually be transported onto the ocean vessel using a RORO ramp, however the available vessels did not have that option and the equipment was urgently needed by the customer. Instead of pushing the timeline back, we arranged for a part-charter through BBC which allowed the vehicles to be lifted onto the vessel by the ship's crane. The majority of the cargo was loaded and secured in the hold of the ship, but one of the vehicles failed to start and needed to be placed on a MAFI trailer and towed to the ship for loading."

"Ocean logistics was only one aspect of the job and our team also handled the export customs brokerage. The team had to get the original titles validated by US Customs before the shipment was loaded which usually takes a minimum of 72 hours. However, the customer did not have that much time to spare so we managed to liaise and work with local customs to get the cargo released in time and avoid any vessel detention."

The vessel, carrying 2,626cbm and 729.4mtn of the customer's cargo, arrived safely at the Port of Dammam in Saudi Arabia seven weeks later.

Polaris UAE Handle
Difficult Chilling Plant
Project





In one of their recent project logistics operations, Polaris Shipping Agencies were called upon to perform the de-commissioning of a chilling plant in Spain which needed to be shipped to the UAE for refurbishment at their Jebel Ali Free Zone customs bonded facility and then subsequently shipped to an African destination.

Despite Covid-19 lockdowns, they managed to act promptly with their associates for the dismantling and sea-worthy packaging for shipping on MAFIs, 40' open-tops and high-cubes.

The main machinery part, which had shipping dimensions of 12.66 x 2.65 x 2.70m and weight of 49mtn, had to be carefully stowed on MAFIs on purpose built supports due to the awkward nature of cargo and for the safe transport with the accessories shipped in containers. The entire operation was carried out under a nominated quality controller's supervision and documented to the satisfaction of all concerned.
