Government of India Entrusts **EXG** for Oxygen Cylinders Project



Express Global Logistics (EXG) successfully executed a project to import 300 oxygen cylinders from China for the Government of India. The shipment comprised a total volume of 108mt of empty cylinders packed in 150 wooden boxes.

A Boeing 747-400F was chartered from Tianjin Binhai International Airport to Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport for the first 252 oxygen cylinders weighing 77mt. The remaining 48 cylinders were brought in on scheduled flights.

EXG's scope involved receiving the 150 wooden boxes, packing and palletising them at the warehouse in China and obtaining export clearance which included hazard clearance due to the batteries in the pressure measuring device on the cylinder. Post export clearance, they were responsible for hiring a charter from the Chinese authorities, receiving the cargo at the Delhi airport, streamlining import custom clearance and loading the shipment on trailers for further transport.

Vishvendra Singh at EXG comments; "It was critical to arrange a charter for the cargo to reach India at short notice in light of the COVID-19 second wave. We coordinated with various government agencies to ensure receipt of the cargo from the shipper in a timely manner. Given the crisis, we obtained permits in China under humanitarian aid and relief cargo.

Due to the original flight exceeding its allotted quota to fly into China, we rescheduled a new one without disrupting the original timeline before ensuring prompt import clearance at the Delhi airport to facilitate the quick transportation of the cargo to its final destination."

All the cargo was cleared safely and without incident, fully meeting the delivery deadlines. Express Global Logistics are committed to provide any assistance to facilitate the logistics of medical equipment in the battle against the COVID-19 pandemic.



Last Christmas, TEU Bulgaria performed with great dedication for an urgent project shipment by air to Kazakhstan with very tight time constraints. After intensive preparations, the operations took place on Christmas Eve (a public holiday in Bulgaria) with the TEU Bulgaria team organising the whole operations from the pick up at the production plant until the take-off of the aircraft.

Three power units, each weighing 10,980kg and measuring 545 x 240 x 285cm, plus several smaller packages, were picked up in Ravno Pole, close to Sofia and delivered to Sofia Airport. Before the pick up, TEU had to create a special wooden case so the power units could be accepted in the aircraft, something the shipper had not considered. At Sofia Airport, the cranes and crew were waiting for the aircraft (a Ilyushin II-76) and the units were prepared ready for the journey. The cargo was then customs cleared and the loading operations were completed in record time (see photos below).

After the aircraft took off bound for Almaty in Kazakhstan, TEU Bulgaria received a special written commendation from their new and very happy customer.



A recent project handled by the specialised NTG team involved a transformer shipped by a part-charter vessel from Naples in Italy to Hvide Sande in Denmark, before onward transportation to it's final destination at an energy field in Søndervig.





The transformer weighed 167tn with dimensions of 830 x 330 x 450cm. NTG handled the whole job including, not only transporting the main transformer, but also hiring specialised gear and manpower for the installation work at the site, along with moving urgently needed anti-vibration pads on a dedicated truck from Italy to ensure the timely installation in Denmark.

Thomas Scherling Hermann (Project Manager at NTG Denmark) explains; "The discharging port is very small and not equipped with suitable shore cranes, so for economical reasons, offloading had to take place by the vessel's own gear and we planned to unload directly onto a specialised truck which was waiting at the quay to move the piece to its final destination. Unfortunately the vessel was delayed and unable to enter the port for almost one week due to bad weather. So to avoid truck demurrage charges, foundations were placed on the quay in order for the vessel to discharge on these, as quickly as possible, allowing the truck to be utilised elsewhere while waiting for the vessel to enter the port. When returning to collect the transformer, the truck simply drove the trailer below the two foundations, thereby loading the pieces without the need for vessel gear or external mobile cranes."

Despite the challenges along the way, the job was completed and delivered in time to a very happy client and end user.

Also photographed in the gallery are some recent projects from NTG Norway who have a long experience in successfully dealing with specialised cargo for oil & gas projects. The projects, which resulted in very pleased clients, include:

- Movement of a new BOP (Blow Out Preventer) from Louisiana in the USA to Bergen in Norway. The cargo consisted of 450th in two pieces.
- Heavy reels from Korea and Malaysia to Norway for the offshore market (from 50-119tn each).

The cargo travelled by ocean from Thailand to California where it was loaded onto trucks and transported to the end user's site in Los Angeles.

R&B Global Complete Challenging Project in Serbia

After their client had barged the cargo from the Netherlands to Pancevo in Serbia, R&B Global Projects were tasked to organise the transshipment in the riverport and transport to the final destination on the outskirts of Belgrade.

The cargo consisted of a drum on saddles at 1865 x 446 x 466cm / 43,000kg and a furnace at 1004 x 337 x 327cm / 30,000kg.

Dave Roosen (Director at R&B) explains; "The busy schedule at the Port of Pan evo was a big factor that had to be overcome in order to successfully organise this transport as it resulted in the barge, two trucks and the cranes waiting because the port had a last minute delivery of train wagons and steel coils and the terminal was full so our unloading was waiting for 2 days taking us into the weekend. R&B and our local partner jumped in and contacted the port authorities to arrange that the wagons were unloaded quickly and we could proceed with the swift unloading of our cargo just after the weekend in order to avoid any further delays.

Once the wagons were moved and our barge was unloaded with only minor delays, we were ready for the road transport. There was a lot of `road furniture' that had to be removed for the transport due to the height including electricity wires, telephones and train cables. Several

C.H. Robinson Project Logistics recently handled the first of over 20 different shipments for a large North American automotive company. The cargo started in France and was transported to the Port of Antwerp to begin its three-week journey over the water to the Port of Baltimore.

Due to ongoing vessel space constraints and equipment scarcity, the C.H. Robinson team had suggested moving the pieces by RORO vessels using MAFI trailers rather than a traditional ocean vessel. Once the customer agreed, they contacted the shipping line to secure space for the current cargo as well as the 19+ sailings to follow.

C.H. Robinson comments; "The RORO method not only provided a way to circumvent the current container vessel shortage but also offered a safer method of shipping the high-value and sensitive equipment as the cargo was able to travel underdeck which protected it from weather as well as limited the number of times the pieces had to be handled. The method was also 30% more cost effective than transporting by flat-racks."

C.H. Robinson Helps Deliver 84.75mt of Project Cargo

The sparkling clean cryogenic trailers were safely delivered to the Port of Santos where they could be put to good use by the medical heroes on the ground in Brazil.

Transportation of 248mt Desalter Vessels by **EXG**
