

Cover: FCI Transport Compressor Train to Germany



Megalift delivered an array of cargo such as a wide variety of machines and lifting equipment which was shipped in containers, breakbulk and RORO vessels.

For this job, Megalift collaborated with fellow PCN member from Australia 'Freightplus' to deliver a Bauer MC86 D-Wall Cutter Machine on DDP basis, from Singapore to Sydney, Australia, including pre-shipment inspection & bio-security control.

FCI TRANSPORT COMPRESSOR TRAIN TO GERMANY

France Cargo International (FCI) are happy to share their recent shipment of a compressor train from Almelo in the Netherlands to Duisburg in Germany.



They transported via trucking and loaded on barge with 2 x 250 metric tonne Mammoet cranes, though they faced obstacles such as low water levels and heavy congestion at the terminals due to both full & empty containers eating up available loading space.

The cargo featured dimensions of 21.67 x 6.34 x 5.25 m and weighed in an impressive 180 tonnes.

HEAVY LOAD SERVICE TRANSPORT TANKS TO INDUSTRIAL SITE

Heavy Load Service (HLS), our members from the Netherlands, recently transported two large tanks. The two pieces of cargo featured dimensions of 1600 x 575 cm and were sailed from the manufacturer by road & barge to Stein.

In Stein, the tanks were transferred onto two HLS trailers to be transported 10km with various obstacles such as trees, traffic lights and traffic signs to the destination site in Chemelot, Geleen. HLS covered a wide scope of services during this entire route from factory to site, including transshipment.

EXG MANAGE 4740 METRIC TONNE MULTIMODAL MOVEMENT

Express Global Logistics, our Members in India, recently arranged the movement of galvanised transmission line towers & their parts for one of the largest infrastructure construction companies.

The total 4740 MT of transmission line towers were shipped via 6 barge trips. The total distance covered for each lot from the shipper's works to the final site in Bangladesh was around 3110 km.

Transportation brought various challenges such as arranging 207 trailers for the movement of cargo, from the shipper's works to the port, as the barging windows at the port of loading were short and precise.

EXG seamlessly completed export clearance, port handling, as well as loading on a barge at origin to avoid any vessel detention or port storage charges. The loading on barges was done under the supervision of EXG's well experienced team who ensured no damage was done to the cargo.


A swift discharge at Bangladesh due to timely import documentation and clearance ensured smooth port handling and delivery at the final site by EXG's team.

The successful delivery was possible only as a result of extensive and precise transport planning. Seamless handling of bundled cargo was done to maximize the space on the barges ensuring absolute stability for sea voyages.

destination as the deliveries were planned to more than 9 separate locations across Bangladesh.



C.H. ROBINSON HAUL TURBINE COMPONENTS FROM KANSAS TO TEXAS

The project logistics experts at C.H. Robinson were recently chosen for a project involving the movement of over 197,790 cubic meters of wind turbine components from a laydown yard in Kansas to a wind farm in Texas.

Rising fuel costs and a shortage of qualified drivers for this type of freight added challenges to the project, however, that didn't stop C.H. Robinson from being able to help their client. On top of this, specialised trucks were required for transportation during this project.

Due to their scale and network of contract carriers, all 56 complete wind turbines traveled the 140 miles to the new wind farm.

"In all, it took 560 truckloads and 48 days to transport the 16,402 metric tons of equipment to the site, which included 168 wind blades measuring 62.2 x 3.94 x 2.9 meters each."
