Khimji Ramdas Shipping, our members from Oman, recently handled the movement of two heavy lift transformers, as well as their accessories, from Sohar Port to the consignee's site.



The volume of the entire shipment measured 5666 CBM, including the grid station accessories which accompanied the power transformers.

A total of 749 packages made up this shipment, with the main bodies of the transformers featuring dimensions of 13.65 (L) x 5.25 (W) x 4.75 (H) meters and weighing 282 MT each. KRS covered a scope of services upon the arrival of the transporting vessel at Sohar Port, some including:

- Customs clearance
- Inspection
- Coordination with liner, port and customs
- Under hook cargo acceptance
- Police permissions & escort .
- Jacking & skidding
- Transportation & delivery

AFRIGUIDE **LOGISTICS SHARE THE COMPLEXITIES OFAUCTION CARGO**

Afriguide Logistics, our members from South Africa, recently wrote a piece on the topic of handling auction cargo.



This type of cargo carries its own challenges, as the goods are usually sold on an "as is, where is" basis - meaning that the responsibility is on the buyer to fetch the cargo which lies in the auction lot. This is fine if the cargo was a light vehicle or any easily moveable item, but when confronted with 100+ tons of dead machinery, it becomes another matter entirely.

"An operation like this requires riggers and cranes on-site, as well as a team of fitters to either dismantle or resurrect the dead machines to get loaded onto road transport."

There is usually no assistance from the auction yard/job site. In fact, more often than not, the site owner will impose several impediments such as requirements for safety and security inductions, risk assessments, limited access windows, etc.

Once the cargo has been extracted, Afriguide move it to an off-dock storage facility where it can be prepared for exporting. From the storage yard, the

cargo is then to be transferred to the port terminal in preparation for shipping.

This usually involves cleaning (for bio-controlled entry points such as USA, Canada, and Australia), parts consolidation, skidding, strapping, crating fall-off and nesting and securing smaller components into buckets, load bodies and blades to reduce freight volume.

"As most of the cargo is not container friendly, it will often require shipping as breakbulk, or on a Mafi trailer as RoRo and static accompanying cargo."

One of the peculiarities of the South African port terminal operators is that they do not actually handle OOG cargo in exchange for the THC that is charged, instead the forwarder is required to arrange for cranes, riggers, Mafi tractors or even direct loading (at an additional expense).

"Fortunately, this is one of Afriguide's specialities and our crew are well versed in making this happen."

STAR SHIPPING MOVE PROJECT SHIPMENT FROM CHINA TO BRAZIL

The cargo transported was loaded at Tianjin Port in China to be discharged in Manaus Port, Brazil.

EXG COMPLETES MOVEMENT OF MANIFOLD PIPES FROM MUNDRA TO SOHAR

The team at Express Global Logistics in India recently handled the transportation of manifold pipes from Mundra Gujarat to Majis Industrial Estate in Sohar, Oman. The package was measured at the following dimensions: 19.60 m (L) x 6.50 m (W) x 3.80 m (H), and was shipped from the West Coast of India to Sohar Port via breakbulk on a container vessel.

EXG discovered a cost-effective solution for their client by using breakbulk on container vessels instead of conventional breakbulk. Their team was responsible for the door delivery of the cargo at the destination port, which included receiving the package under hook alongside the vessel, customs clearance of the package, and then transportation on axles to the final delivery site.

"Our team's ability to overcome unexpected challenges with a positive, problem-solving approach made for a timely delivery of the cargo and happy clients!"

An additional shore crane was required for the lifting operations and had to be arranged at short-notice,

"The final delivery was challenging as obstacle removal was required en route, including the dismantling of additional obstacles at the final site, which was arranged and coordinated successfully along with our partner in Oman."

- A trash recycling machine from Germany to Japan. CTO Germany handled the transport from the factory on trucks to the port of loading before shipping on MAFI trailers on a RORO vessel with secure seaworthy packing.



GRAND ARABIA EMPOWER JORDANIAN WOMEN WITH PASSION PROJECT

Mr. Marwan Oweiss, General Manager of Grand Arabia Forwarding & Logistic Services (PCN Member in Iraq and Jordan) and Board Member of the Jordanian Logistics Association presented Rachel with a jar of honey during PCN's recent 11th Annual Summit.

But this is not normal honey!

Marwan explains "The Honey Oweisses refers to our family name Oweiss and the venture was started in order to empower Jordanian women in rural areas by helping them become economically powerful so that they give back to the community and help improve society."

The project's vision is:

- Students' education and well-being (paying school tuition fees for needy school students, arranging fun days for unfortunate students)
- Women empowerment (creating job opportunities)
- Creating awareness of the benefits of honeybees
- Exporting raw and pure Jordanian honey to different destinations

Marwan adds "Part of our honey sales revenue will go towards educating the needy students in our country, which is another small project that we started a few years ago. We strongly believe that educating children and empowering woman will positively and enormously improve societies. All of our honey is bottled by hand to support the local economy by creating jobs. We are also looking for opportunities to export pure Jordanian honey produced in our local apiaries overseas. We strongly believe that pure honey could be a good remedy for many diseases and hope that our honey will be reachable to all those who need it."

M-STAR PROJECTS TRANSPORT HUMANITARIAN AID TO UKRAINE

M-Star Projects are glad to share what work they have organised in humanitarian aid to West-Ukraine from Europe. As the war has progressed, the need for help to the Ukrainian people increased, and M-Star sought to uplift the transportation of relief goods for NGOs, governments and private organisations in support of Ukraine.

"Now we are arranging all different types of relief goods: foodstuffs, medicals, beds/blankets, generators, heating equipment, water tanks and also now the ambulances, medical support cars, tents, road building machine, excavators, garbage trucks and so on."

In addition, M-Star is handling the transshipment of cargo arriving from across the world in the major European ports to Ukraine.

"Now we expect a further increase in transport demands."

M-Star are fully supported by their Ukrainian truckers, and they have coordinated with their Ukrainian partners to handle the growing demand. The relief goods are now transported to cities such as Lviv, Kiev, Odessa, Lutsk, Kharkov, Poltava, Ivano-Frankivsk and more, as long as it is safe and sanctioned by Ukrainian military officials.





EUROPE CARGO HANDLE 253-TON HEAT EXCHANGER IN ANTWERP

Europe Cargo, our members from Belgium, recently discharged a hefty 253-ton heat exchanger ex-barge to terminal using a floating crane at Port Antwerp-Bruges. The crane was positioned alongside the barge with scrubbers attached for lifting. It was moved slowly and carefully allowing balance at all times.

When high enough, the barge sailed and the crane approached alongside the terminal quay. Slings were used to gently lower the heavy cargo onto wooden ground.

Finally, the heat exchanger was loaded onto its designated sea vessel with prepared flats for safe delivery.



JSL QATAR COMPLETE INDUSTRIAL PLANT RELOCATION PROJECT

JSL Global Qatar have recently reported a large undertaking involving the relocation of an industrial plant from Qatar to Constanta, Romania. JSL provided a feasibility study to their client almost 8 months prior to actual shipment delivery date.

The main challenge the company ran into during the exporting of this plant ex-Qatar was the multiple owners of the factory. Many of the owners changed and most of the material was procured locally from Turkiye and the UAE. Additionally, the original shipping documents were missing which meant JSL were required to authenticate the ownership and generated export documents.

To overcome this obstacle, JSL Qatar worked with multiple governmental agencies to put the case to the authorities. After 6 weeks of rigorous follow up, the relevant authorities approved the export.

Another challenge awaited JSL due to the on-going war between Russia and Ukraine. Breakbulk rates proved too high and their client was operating on a strict budget. JSL reached out to European vessel owners and made this transport possible with committed, budgeted figures. Police escorts & route surveys were key factors in this project, considering the longest pieces of cargo which measured at 28 and 32 meters. JSL's project team planned to place these two girders on a multiaxle trailer after several meetings with heavy lift haulers.

After loading the cargo at the site in Qatar, when JSL began their route, the convoy plus escort vehicles were measured at 112 meters long!

The JSL project team worked with the staff at Q-Terminal continuously for 3 days, personally supervising the safe off-loading of cargo inside Hamad Port, which was then loaded aboard the breakbulk vessel MV Rudolf. A third party cargo survey was also carried out by JSL to ensure safety was kept as a top priority.

Finally - after import customs formalities, the full shipment was delivered to their client within one week's time to avoid any issues with port storage. JSL handled this difficult plant relocation successfully, and the cargo was safely delivered to the client's site in Romania.

BEE LOGISTICS HANDLE BREAKBULK SHIPMENT FOR FACTORY CONSTRUCTION

Bee Logistics are pleased to share their recent handling of a breakbulk shipment involving construction and factory equipment for a new industrial site in Vietnam.

The cargo involved in this shipment included a large steam boiler, a crane and steel structure as well as 75 packages. The total volume of the two larger units, as well as 75 smaller packages, came to 2,230 cubic meters and a weight of 399 tons. The boiler itself featured a length of 31 meters, a diameter of 3.2 meters and an individual unit weight of 81 tons.

Thanks to the diligence of the Bee Logistics team, this delivery was completed successfully and safely on-time.
