

This project involves the transportation of gas turbines for a new cogeneration plant that has nearly reached completion.

Arguably the most essential piece of equipment for the cogeneration plant, the two SGT-750 gas turbines that Eastship delivered, will be used to transform natural gas into electricity.

Boris Bucur, General Manager of Rompetrol Energy, had this to say of the project:


"The installation of the turbines was one of the most important steps in the construction of the cogeneration plant, a large-scale project that will allow us to create a viable energy solution for the Petromidia platform, but also our National Energy System."

The new power plant will generate approximately 80 MW of electricity - of which approximately 60-70 MW will be used for the consumption needs of the Petromidia platform.

"At the moment, the project is more than 80% completed."



TERA SHIPPING DELIVER TO KOREA FOR OIL & GAS INDUSTRY



Tera Shipping, our members from Malaysia, are glad to share an update of a recent movement they executed within the oil & gas industry.

Their project team picked up the cargo from their client's location, featuring nine packages with a total weight of 643 MT and a volume of 3,614 cbm.

The largest piece of cargo was measured at 18.5 (L) x 15.0 (W) x 12.7 (H) meters and weighed 605 tonnes. This was specially transported using an SPMT to a private jetty nearby before being loaded onto a barge.

It was then carried by barge to the nearest port at Port Klang West to be loaded with a double banking operation onto an HLV that Tera's team chartered.

The hefty unit was secured on deck, fastened and set sail to its destination: Sungdong Shipyard in Korea.

"We are glad to report this recent success, and look forward to a prosperous future ahead of this tough economic year."





RETEMS LOGISTICS SHARE VOLUME ON 2023 PROJECTS

RETEMS Logistics, our members from Azerbaijan, are pleased to share with us the total volume of breakbulk and oversized/overweight shipments which they delivered during the first quarter of 2023.

A total of eight charter vessels were shipped, with main items of cargo collected from China, Korea, India, Italy and Turkiye. The heaviest item amongst these weighed 210 tonnes and more than six units featured diameters over 6 meters.

The total volume of all the projects measured 30,000 CBM.

During these projects, RETEMS Logistics covered services such as:

Coordination with port & vessel operations

- Route surveys & method statements
- Export/import customs clearance
- Obtaining special permissions
- Full/part chartering
- Port documentation
- Breakbulk, RO/RO
- Civil works

They also encountered some difficulties:

The delivery of goods through the Volga-Don Canal proved challenging during the current period of hostilities between the Russian Federation and Ukraine in the Black Sea.

Furthermore, the movement of cargo ships through the Kerch Strait was and remains temporarily closed. However, within a month, RETEMS Logistics were able to obtain permission to pass under the Crimean Bridge with their cargo, allowing all the equipment to be delivered to the final destination.

"We believe that such projects raise the level of professionalism for RETEMS Logistics, and we thank all our partners who offered great support."







W.I.S. ITALY CONTRACTED FOR OVERSIZED MOTOR MOVEMENT

W.I.S. Italy were recently awarded a contract to transport eleven oversized cases of motors from Moenchengladbach, Germany to Kazakhstan.

The larger units required transport permits, being measured at 331 cm wide and 390 cm high. From Germany, all cases had to be transported individually on low-loaders.

After loading, the trucks proceeded to the Port of Sete in France to board the ferry to Istanbul. Once there, the cases were transshipped within a customs bonded facility.

The trucks then took a route from Turkiye to Georgia, Azerbaijan (via ferry from Baku to Kazakhstan) and on to their final destination. The total transit time will be within 23-30 days.

ELEMENT LOGISTICS DELIVER STEAM SYSTEMS TO UZBEKISTAN




Element International Logistics are glad to share a report of two steam boilers & burners that they recently shipped from Turkiye to Uzbekistan.

The shipment was completed using lowbed trucks, with the dimensions of the cargo being measured at 10.70 (H) x 3.20 (W) x 3.80 (H) meters and a weight of 32,000 kg.

SEA HORSE LOGISTICS DELIVER ABNORMAL LOAD ACROSS 1,500 KM

Sea Horse Logistics, our members from Uganda, are pleased to report on a movement they recently concluded for an abnormal cargo load from Kenya.

The shipment was received at Mombasa Port to be delivered to a site in Luwero, Central Uganda - a distance of approximately 1,500 kilometres.

The cargo itself was out-of-gauge and came in two parts weighing 85 MT. Due to the abnormal weight and size, the journey from Mombasa Port to the site took 31 days.

"We are proud to have successfully handled such large cargo."

EZ LINK & HACKLIN LOGISTICS EXECUTE OOG CARGO MOVEMENT

EZ Link, our members from Taiwan, recently cooperated with Hacklin Logistics - fellow PCN members from Finland - to execute a time critical shipment between their respective countries.





Their client's request involved a yacht with measured dimensions of 8.35 (L) x 2.59 (W) x 2.90 (H) meters, and weighed 2954 kilograms.

Hacklin Logistics received and loaded the cargo onto a low-bed trailer at the site and arranged the delivery to the carrier's warehouse for re-loading onto a 40' flat rack container. It was then shipped from the Port of Rauma in Finland by feeder vessel to be connected to the mother container vessel at Hamburg Port before onwards shipping to Kaohsiung Port in Taiwan.

Due to the tight scheduling of the shipment, EZ Link and Hacklin provided

their client with the most suitable solutions to ensure a timely arrival, despite Hacklin facing disruptions of a stevedore strike; as well as a shortage of 40' flat rack equipment in the ports of Finland.

Both members kept their supplier and consignee informed & updated of all situations, including the status of the strikes and their impact on the cargo transportation.

"By the great cooperation and communication between EZ Link and Hacklin, the clients were satisfied with our offering of 'timely and reliable service."

SHIPWAY COMPLETE MOVEMENT OF RADAR SYSTEM TO NIGERIA

Shipway, our members from Argentina, were recently involved in an air freight shipment of two large units from Bariloche, Argentina to Abuja, Nigeria.

The main unit was a radar system with dimensions of $6.10 \, (L) \, x \, 2.44 \, (W) \, x \, 2.59 \, (H)$ meters and a weight of $6,500 \, \text{kilograms}$, whilst the secondary unit was an operators shelter which featured the same dimensions but a greater weight of $7,650 \, \text{kilograms}$.

Both units were moved from their client's premises to the international airport of San Carlos de Bariloche, due to be loaded into a Hercules C-130 provided by the Argentina Air Force.

The Hercules made three technical stops before reaching the final destination as follows: Iguazu (AR), Natal (BR), Cape Verde (CV) and finally Abuja (Nigeria).

Shipway's scope of operations included full coordination and services from the client's premises in Bariloche, all the way up to the final destination in Abuja, including:

- Labelling cargo and issuing documentation of dangerous goods
- Loading of aircraft and dealings with airport authorities
- Full coordination with the Argentina Air Force
- Aircraft discharging operations in Abuja
- Trucking, cranes provision
- Customs clearance
