3P LOGISTICS COMPLETE OVERSIZED PROJECT FROM CHINA TO SWEDEN

Ilya Goncharov, Global Project Manager of **3p Logistics** is pleased to share a movement that he and Global Project Director **Niels Chr. V. Andersen** coordinated from the first to the final touches. This shipment was organised for a new 'green tech' manufacturer of the world's most environmentally-friendly mineral fertiliser, and the destination was in a beautiful area of Sweden - the **port of Köpmanholmen**.

In the electric car battery manufacturing and pulp industries, workers in Sweden will manufacture a **sustainable mineral fertiliser** from residual products. They will use traditional and proven processing technology powered by **fossil-free electricity**.



Ilya Goncharov, Project Manager, offered his own comments:

"This will be an important contribution to the green transformation of agriculture, and it is an honor for 3p Logistics to be a part of such a unique project."

The largest piece of cargo involved in this shipment featured a great diameter of over seven meters. Ilya and Niels decided on a "net zero" method of transport using the new LNG-powered CMA CGM vessel 'Concorde', which travelled from **China to Hamburg**.

"One giant crystallizer had the size equal of twenty-four standard containers on the vessel!"

In total, 3p Logistics moved two huge breakbulk items and seven OOG items. In height and width, this marked the biggest in 3PL history with a measurement of **7.0 (H) x 7.4 (W) meters!**

The company used a floating crane to unload from the vessel, as well as for loading a barge for delivery between the terminals in **Hamburg**.

Afterwards, the goods were transloaded to 3PL's breakbulk vessel in Hamburg before finally being delivered to the final site in Sweden.




PCN HEAD OFFICE ANNOUNCE 12TH ANNUAL SUMMIT ATTENDANCE
