



DY CONDUCT BULK SHIPMENT FROM SHANGHAI TO KWANGYANG, KOREA

DY ULC, our members from South Korea, recently and successfully delivered on another bulk shipment from China to Korea. The successful execution of this general bulk shipment was realised through reviewing and aligning the cargo conditions, characteristics and specifications.

DY ULC transported two main items of cargo alongside **nineteen packages**. The dimensions of the cargo measured to be **365 cbm** with a weight of **74 MT**.

This shipment was received from Longwu Terminal at Shanghai Port in China, before being transported overseas to Kwangyang Port in Korea.

DY ULC EXECUTE BULK SHIPMENT FROM **ANTWERP TO BUSAN**


PCN members in South Korea, DY ULC recently executed a breakbulk shipment from Antwerp in Belgium to Busan. DY ULC received an optimal service for the shipment from HMM Copenhagen and they express their gratitude for the project.


However, due to the recent incidents in the Red Sea, there were concerns as the route was to pass through the Suez Canal. Therefore, re-routing was arranged to ensure the safety of the crews, cargo and vessel.

The shipment consisted of a total of thirteen units, including a disassembled axial compressor, its accessories, and parts of a motor blower.

The main unit of OOG cargo weighed 130,350 kilograms with a volume of 177.8 cbm. It has dimensions of 8.2 (L) x 4.5 (W) x 4.8 (H) meters and was moved BTS and STS using a floating crane.

The remaining units were shipped in a 40' open-top container.

Automobile Presses to Mexico - Multimodal Transportation of

 Combining their chartering & project forwarding DNA, Baggio partchartered two different vessels for the ocean and road moves of 15 heavylifts units from Brazil to inner Mexico. As well as being time-sensitive and requiring a sequenced delivery at the jobsite, the automotive presses were as high as 4.8m and as heavy as 132mtn. With proper planning and having boots-on-the-ground both in Brazil and Mexico, Baggio successfully executed the project, exceeding the client's expectations.

- Baggio was given the challenging task of shipping a large A-Frame piece from Newcastle in the UK to Rio de Janeiro, where it would be installed on a PLSV. Under time pressure and severe draft restrictions due to a short tidal window at the origin shipyard, Baggio was able to safely and timely load and deliver the piece and its accessories.

Baggio was asked in short notice to find a suitable vessel to load three locomotives to Chile and the challenge was accepted! With yet another demonstration of their chartering and forwarding combined mentalities, Baggio looked for combination cargo which could help build the necessary voyage. So by acting as brokers to a major Brazilian pulp producer, Baggio was able to combine and build the shipment of 3 x 139mtn locomotives to

1. Urgent Rotor Transport Frame Mobilisation:

The frame, with shipping dimensions of 1,455 x 215 x 166 cm and weighing approximately 16 MT, was returned from Europe. This critical frame is part of a faulty rotor currently in operation at the Dubai Electricity & Water Authority.

Recognising the urgency, Polaris promptly airlifted the shipment and successfully completed customs clearance. The frame was delivered to contractors on-site within the agreed time frame, allowing the company to proceed with the rotor repair shipment.

2. Other Noteworthy Accomplishments:

- Construction Equipment Shipment: Polaris efficiently handled around 3000 FRT of construction equipment from China to the UAE for an esteemed auction company.
- Seamless Carbon Steel Pipes: Approximately 4500 FRT of seamless carbon steel pipes were imported from Japan to the UAE. These pipes will be shipped to CIS destinations upon completion of necessary pipelining procedures.
- All Terrain Grove Cranes: Polaris secured a contract for shipping around 15 units of all-terrain groove cranes, each weighing 70 tons per unit, from Fremantle, Australia & Haiphong, Vietnam to Mumbai, India. The trial shipment of one unit has already been discharged at Port Mumbai.


