West End and Live Entertainment On your Doorstep

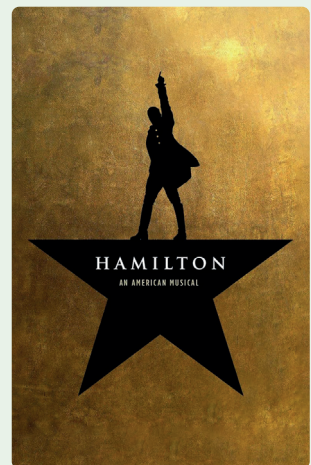
Apollo Victoria Theatre

3-minute walk away, this iconic venue currently hosts the hit musical Wicked.

Book shows in advance to secure the best seats.



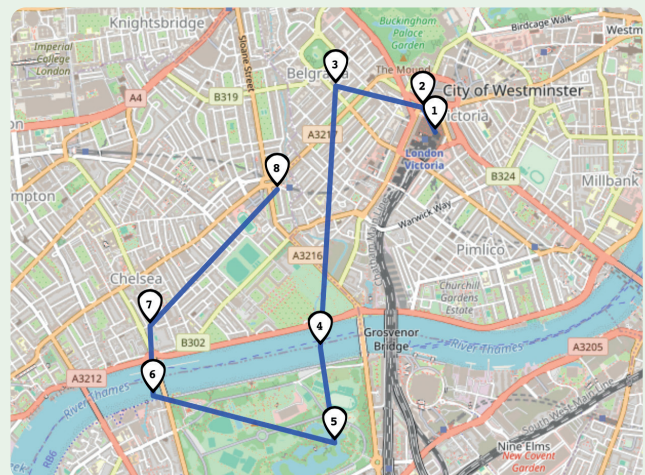
Riverside Royal Route Walking Tour

(approx. 2.5 miles / 4 km)

This walking route from the Park Plaza Victoria Hotel offers a perfect blend of world-famous landmarks, tucked-away treasures, and authentic local flavour.

It's a scenic and insightful stroll that can be enjoyed in 1.5 to 2.5 hours, depending on how often you stop to soak it all in.

Riverside Royal Route Walking Tour Guide

(approx. 2.5 miles / 4 km)

Start Park Plaza Victoria Hotel

1 Little Ben Clock Tower

Just outside Victoria Station, this charming miniature of Big Ben is often missed by tourists, but it's a delightful little landmark to kick off your walk.

2 Belgravia

Wander through one of London's most refined neighbourhoods.

- Admire elegant white stucco townhouses, embassies, and hidden mews like Eaton Mews North.
- Don't miss a sweet stop at Peggy Porschen Cakes, famous for its pastel-pink storefront and irresistible treats.

3 Chelsea Bridge

Head down to the Thames and cross Chelsea Bridge.

- Enjoy sweeping river views, especially beautiful at sunset.
- A great spot for scenic photos!

4 Battersea Park

Across the bridge lies this spacious riverside park, a green haven with landscaped gardens, fountains, and even a small zoo.

- Be sure to visit the Peace Pagoda, a tranquil Buddhist monument with lovely riverside views.

5 Albert Bridge (Return Crossing)

Leave the park via the iconic Albert Bridge.

- Known as one of London's prettiest bridges, it's especially magical when lit up at dusk.

6 Chelsea Embankment

Stroll along the north bank of the river, passing colourful houseboats and stunning Georgian townhouses.

- Feeling peckish? Try The Ivy Chelsea Garden for a refined bite or The Phene for relaxed drinks in a leafy pub garden.

7 Sloane Square / King's Road

Wrap up in this chic London hub of boutique shops, cafés, and the contemporary Saatchi Gallery await.

End Hop on the Tube or a quick bus and you'll be back at Victoria in under 10 minutes.
